

Commercial Smart Controller Rebate Program

Eligibility

- Commercial, multi-family, industrial, or institutional properties must be located within CUWCD's service area (Duchesne, Juab, Salt Lake, Utah, Uintah Wasatch, or the Francis and Woodland areas of Summit County)
- Smart Controller must be WaterSense labeled. A list of WaterSense labeled product models can be found here: <https://lookforwatersense.epa.gov/products/>
- Incentives may be offered for expansion keys, antennas, 4G cartridges, flow meters, and master valves.
- Flow meters and master valves must be plumbed into the system and connected to the irrigation controller.

Requirements

- Applications must be submitted within **90** days of purchase
- Must have qualifying receipt. Receipts/invoices from a company with which the applicant is affiliated are not accepted
- Product must be installed before the application is submitted
- Photos of installed new smart controller must be submitted and labeled with property address
- Photo of serial number on the device

Rebate

- Rebate amount is 50% of the purchase price, not to exceed \$1500.00 (purchase price excludes tax, shipping fees, and installation cost)
- Rebate check must be paid to the owner of the property where the product is installed, not the contractor or third party

Application

- Items for application:
 - Water utility account number
 - Sales receipt or invoice detailing all components
 - Photo of the installed controller, other eligible components, and serial number of device/s
 - Address and description of where device is installed on the property
